Supply List:

- **Paper:** lined paper, copy paper, construction paper, spiral notebooks (especially 5-subject), composition books, index cards
- **Pencils & Pens:** blue or black pens, #2 pencils, mechanical pencils and replacement lead, colored pencils, erasers, pencil sharpener, pencil case, colored markers, crayons, highlighters, dry-erase markers
- **General Supplies:** small dry-erase boards, paper clips, 3-ring 2" binders, pocket folders, report covers
- **Classroom staples:** stapler, staples, rulers, protractors, glue sticks, scissors, tape, tape rolls for tape dispensers, calculators (we have a special need for several calculators)
- **Misc. supplies:** tissues, sanitizing wipes, hand sanitizer
- **Backpacks:** all sizes (we have a special need for several large backpacks, appropriate for high school students)
